Is your child struggling in school?

Here's what to look for:

- Can't sleep at night
- Doesn't socialize well with other children
- Is easily distracted
- Has trouble remembering details
- Can't retell you what you said
- Seems unorganized
- Easily frustrated
- Withdrawn

What do you do first?

- Keep in close contact with your child's teacher
- Provide extra help at home
- Use all interventions offered at school
- Ask for help
- Talk to your child

Tri-Valley Schools offer:
