Admission Requirements

What we are looking for in a candidate:

Students meeting an academic requirement of a 3.75 cumulative grade point average or above receive applications for membership in Tri Valley Middle School Honor Society. While the academic criterion remains important, the qualities of leadership, character and citizenship are also areas of consideration. Honor Society members will be evaluated on these three traits in several ways. Those candidates who have served Saturday School, In School Suspension, Out of School Suspension or more than one after-school detention this school year will not be eligible for membership in TVMS Honor Society. A faculty council will meet at the beginning of the 4th grading period to evaluate the applications. Those students who meet all the requirements will be invited to join Tri Valley Middle School Honor Society.

How we will be selecting members:

- **Service:** participation in 3 service projects (before the end of the 3rd grading period) totaling a minimum of 15 hours. Hours must be accumulated outside of school hours.
- **Leadership/Citizenship:** must be an active member in good standing of 2 extra-curricular or co-curricular including all sports, band and TVMS clubs /community activities and clubs, such as 4-H, Scouts and church clubs.
- **Character:** If the above have been satisfied, a writing prompt on personal character will be given at the beginning of the 4th quarter.
